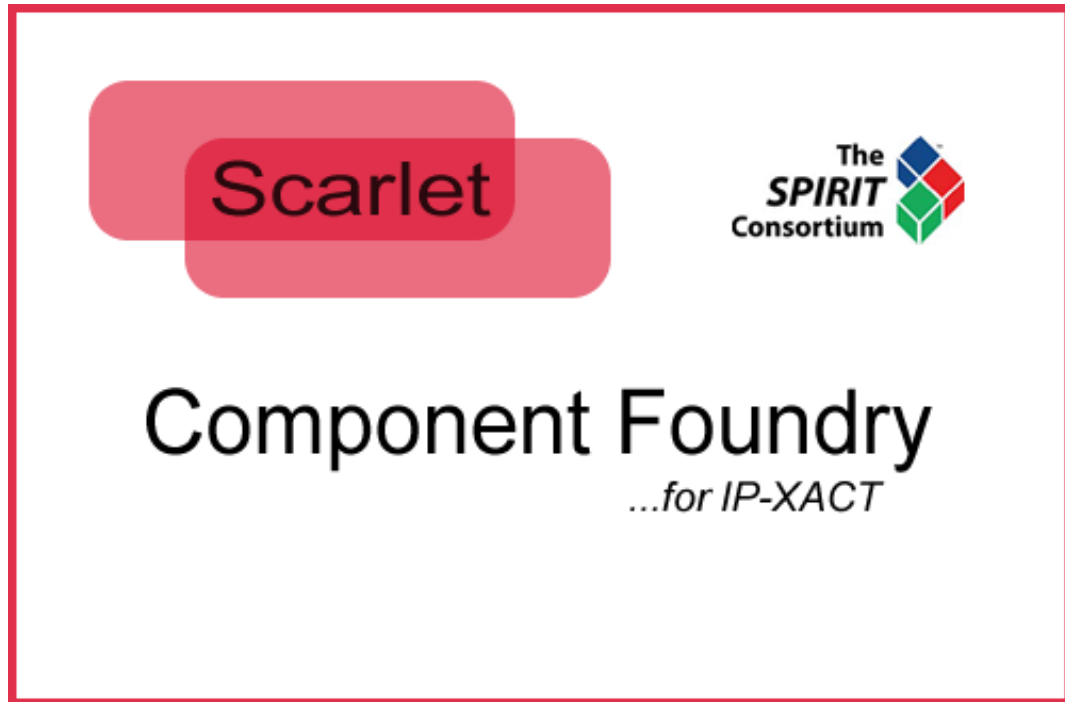

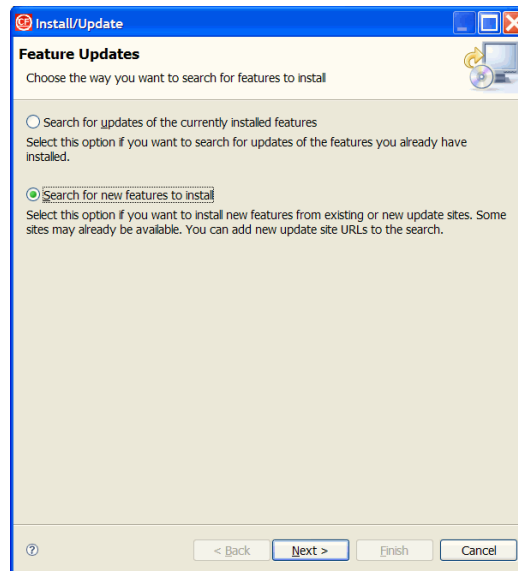

1. Purpose

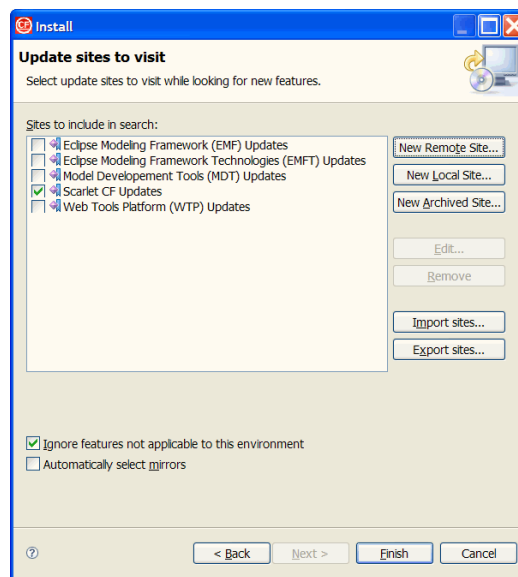
This document gives some guidance in how to obtain and install an update for Scarlet Code Component Foundry. *It assumes that a copy of Scarlet Code Component Foundry is already installed and running on the target machine.*

1.1 Updates

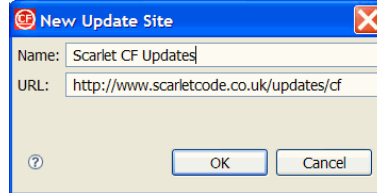
From the *Help* menu, select *Software Updates – Find and Install...* The following wizard should appear.



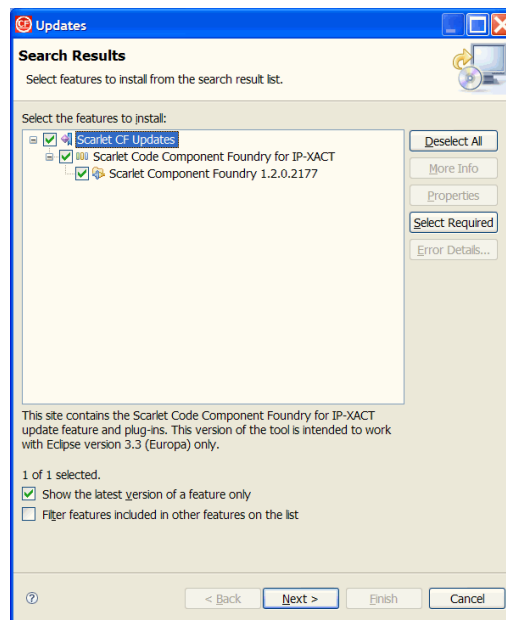
Select *Search for new features to install* and press *Next*.



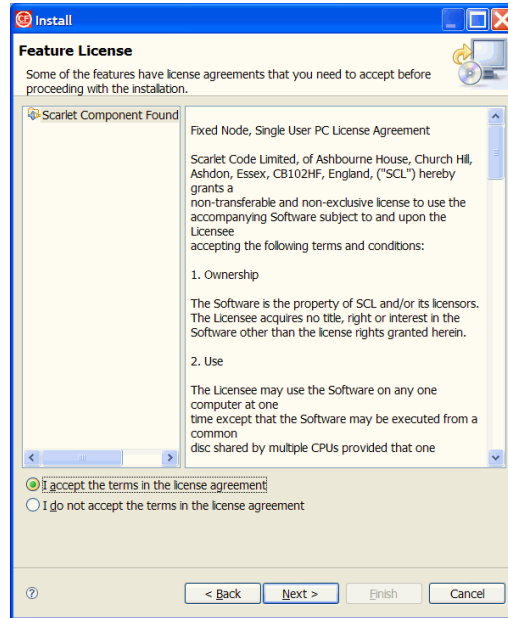
On the *Update sites to visit* page, an update site for Scarlet Code Component Foundry may already be present. If it is, ensure it is selected. If however, the Scarlet CF Updates site is not present, select the *New Remote site* button, and in the dialog enter Scarlet CF Updates for the name and <http://www.scarletcode.co.uk/updates/cf> for the URL, then select *OK*.



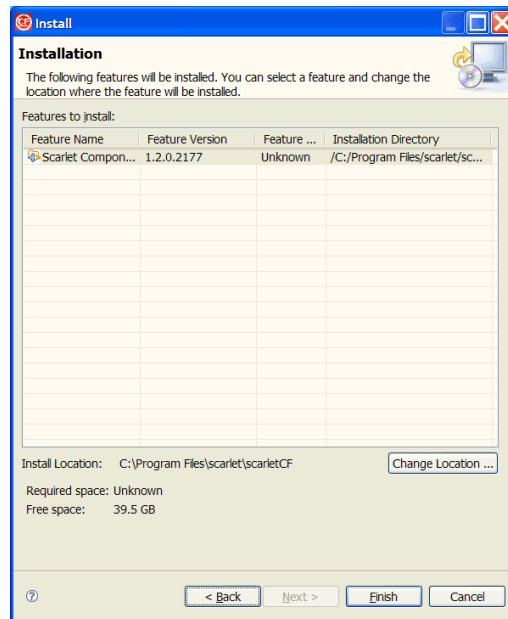
In the wizard, select *Finish*. After a short time something similar to the following page should appear.



Select *Scarlet CF Updates* and press *Next*.

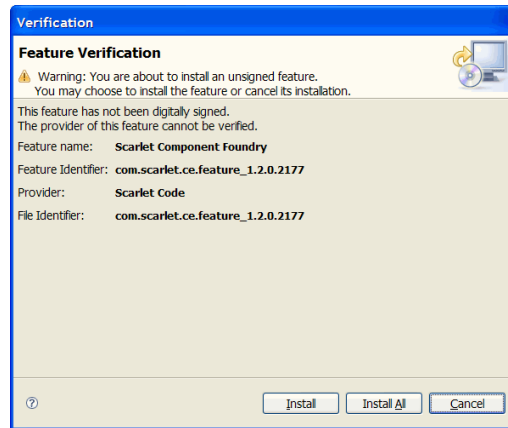


Select *I accept the terms in the license agreement* and press *Next*.



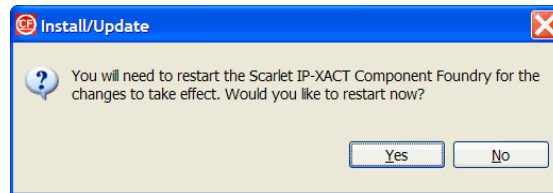
Review the feature(s) to be installed, and press *Finish*.

After a time, depending on your download speed, a *Feature Verification* dialog will be displayed.



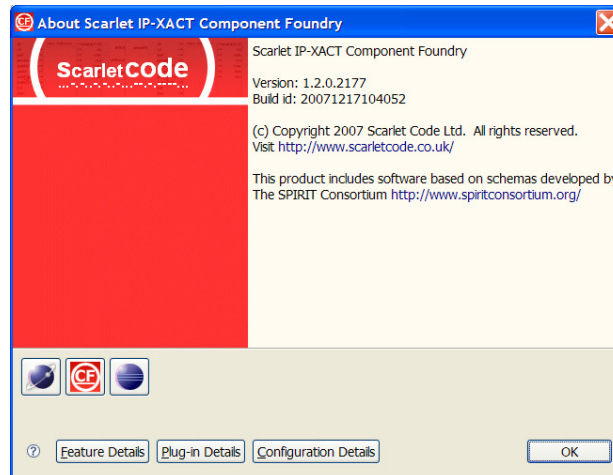
Select *Install All*.

When installation is complete, the following message will be displayed.



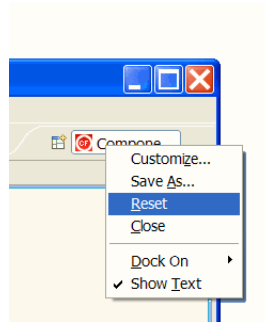
Select *Yes*.

When Scarlet Code Component Foundry has restarted, you may check that the version has updated correctly by selecting *Help – About Scarlet IP-XACT Component Foundry*.



1.2 Update Perspective

On occasion, an update may provide new options for views and menus. These new options will not always appear unless the Component Foundry *perspective* is reset. To do this, right-click on the Component Foundry perspective button and select *Reset*. Resetting the perspective does, however, restore the editors and views to their default sizes and positions.
